



## Dr. Satyapal Singh

Dr. Satyapal Singh is the head of the Target Olympic Medal Sports Academy. His achievements include being the youngest ever Dronacharya Awardee and being one of the most successful International coaches from India. But before he decided to become one of a premier coach, he was an excellent athlete himself.

During his athletic career (1993-2003), Dr. Satyapal participated in plenty of National, University and State level competitions. He won a bronze medal at the IAAF World Athletics Day Towards Edmonton 2001. Apart from that he took part at the National stage 8 times won 19 medals at University level competitions. Dr. Satyapal Singh also won 14 medals at State Competitions.

Alongside his 10 year career in sports he pursued his education in sports. Dr. Singh has done his Masters in Physical Education. He is also a Doctor of Philosophy in Sports and Athletics. Furthermore, he has completed multiple certificate courses including those in Yoga and the IAAF Technical Officials course (Level-1). He also has quite the passion for teaching, he is an Assistant Professor at Delhi University.

As one of India's most successful international coaches he has worked with a multitude of national and international sporting bodies. His roles as a member of organisations have ranged from Competition manager of Athletics Federation of India (2006-2009) and a coach of the Indian Para-athletics team from 2007 in 35 International competitions including multiple Olympic (2008 & 2016), Asian(2010, 2014 & 2018) and Commonwealth Games (2010)

His 15 years of career as a coach has seen him become the Chief Coach for the World Para Athletics Championships and the World Para Athletics Junior Championships in 2019 for the Indian team.
